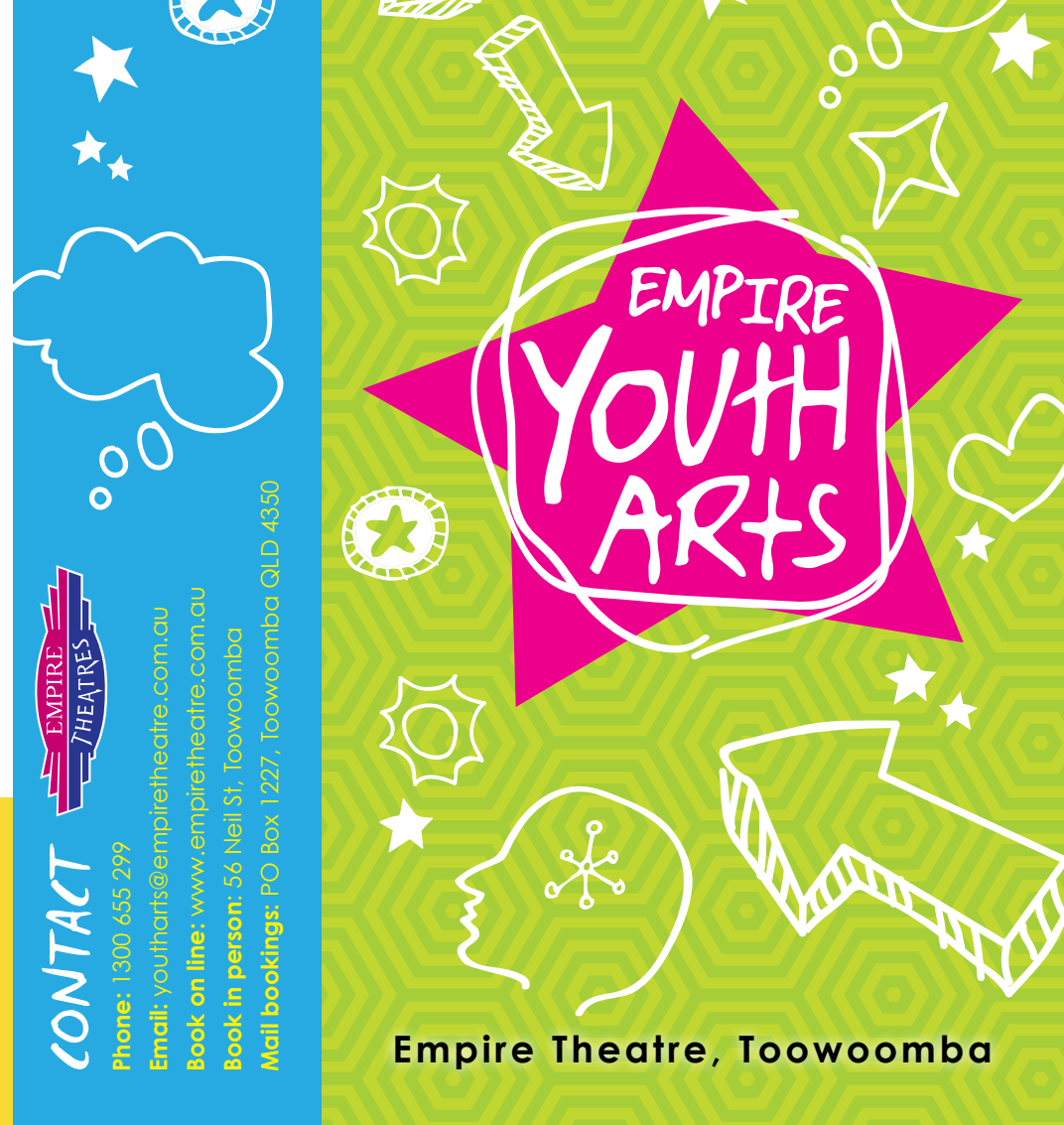

Drama Workshops

Drama One

Grades 5 to 7; Ages 10 to 12

Use your imagination! Build your self-confidence! Communicate without fear! Perform with like-minded peers! Act and play a variety of characters in a whole new world of contexts. All while having heaps of fun! Drama One is about learning basic performance and creative skills and at the same time building self-confidence and focus, while working with like-minded young people. Students will be given the opportunity to share their skills in performance.

It will provide unique opportunities to build creative learning at a level above curriculum learning.
