
















I have inherited a superb organisation from former Chair Peter Swannell, AM and I wish to place on the public record my sincere appreciation for all that Peter and his wife Janice has done for the Theatre over the last 20 years.

The financial result for Empire Theatre Pty Ltd was pleasing with a closing balance of \$74,114. It is also important to note the within budget deficit delivered by Empire Theatre Projects Pty Ltd which allows the Theatres to continue to build the cultural capacity in our community.

With over 141,125 attendees and 981 events held at the precinct over the last 12 months, the team at the Theatres, led admirably by GM Kerry Saul and his team of around 40 full time and casual staff continue to provide industry recognised service and expertise. We are proud of the range and quality of the diverse programming we provide our local community.

All eyes now turn to the upcoming year and whilst we are looking forward to another exciting year of performances, a big focus of the team over the next 12 months is the upcoming refurbishment of the "Jewel in the Crown" including an accessible box office, additional bathrooms and replacing the seating in the main auditorium

Our major production, *Esgees Pirates of Penzance*, jointly presented with Heritage Bank as our wonderful presenting partner, received great reviews and was a high quality event. We have continued our emphasis on providing regular opportunity for young participants in the form of performance and workshop events. All of this activity is providing pathways for local artists to improve their craft and skills. We also completed our busiest year since reopening in 1997 with record numbers of patrons and events.

It has been both a challenging and successful time for the Friends but we have continued to support the Theatre with a volunteer workforce, personal promotions and significant donations.

EMPIRE THEATRES FOUNDATION | Chair's Report

It's been another busy and interesting year for the Foundation.

Administratively, operational 'consolidation' with the Theatre resulted in a shift in focus, with valued assistance from the Head of Marketing and Development, the Projects Manager, and General Manager.

Key achievements were the development of a Sponsor/Donor brochure, the generous support of a new Foundation sponsor, Bernoth Properties, and an increase in cash donations from community supporters. Foundation funding and grant applications continued to assist the Empire's skills development activities throughout the year.

In July, *ACO Virtual*, the Foundation's collaboration with the Toowoomba Regional Art Gallery, attracted nearly 3,500 visitors. In November, 25 talented Youth Bursary recipients gained short-course training opportunities. In May, lyric tenor Michael Petruccelli received the 2018 Brian Boak Outstanding Performer Bursary for 12 months'

study at Frankfurt Oper. The History sub-committee continued to assess and archive items of interest which came to light throughout the year.

Trustees also advocated for the wider recognition of the Empire's work over the past two decades by enhancing skills in talented performers through classes, workshops and performance opportunities.

None of this could have been achieved without our donors and sponsors, the hard work of all Trustees, Foundation Officer Kate Brennan, Minutes Secretary Susan Cherry and the support of Board Chairman Andrew Wielandt, Directors and Empire staff. I thank them all, especially Deputy Chair Janelle Davis for her tireless involvement in all facets of Foundation operations.

Additional Language Development through Theatre Practice

Harristown High School – During all school terms

For 75 minutes each week, the Empire Theatres
Projects Company use the arts to aid the learning
of Harristown State High School's newly arrived,
migrant and refugee student population. A diverse
group of students take part in the project, including
students from Pakistan, Afghanistan, Iraq, Iran, South
America and various African nations.

The work done in this program, lead by Youth Arts Director Ari Palani, was able to assist with the participants learning and also helped with survivability, viability and adaptability in the local community.

ACO Virtual

1-30 July 2017 - Toowoomba Art Gallery

Before the Australian Chamber Orchestra's ACO Collective took to the stage in September 2017, the Empire Theatres presented the *ACO Virtual* Installation at Toowoomba Art Gallery.

More than 1000 people visited the gallery for the installation with a large number of young people along with parents attending the event.

ACO Virtual used state of the art technology and featured projections of 12 of the ACO's acclaimed musicians. Within the installation, the audience was surrounded with the sound of each musician coming from the direction of their individual projections.

Touch screen technology allowed the audience to step inside a concert, be immersed in a cinematic experience and provided an extraordinary new way to experience music.

The Arrival

Friday 20 October 2017, 11am & 6pm

Spare Parts Puppet Theatre's unique theatrical experience, *The Arrival*, was based on the highly popular and meaningful book by Shaun Tan. Using acting, non-verbal communication and puppetry to tell the story, *The Arrival* brought a fantastic world to life, telling a universal tale of the challenge of arriving in a new country.

As many new refugee and migrant arrivals are settling in Toowoomba, this show was chosen and Mercy Community Services were happy to support the event.

In order to better communicate the content and themes of this show to the newly arrived community, Mercy Community Services (MCS) assisted us to translate the flyer into three languages additional to the English flyers, including Farsi Dari, Arabic and French. MCS also provided free tickets as part of the sponsorship which were distributed to foster children and refugee and migrant networks throughout the city.

More than 700 people attended the performances across the season with around 300 of those being MCS clients who would not have had the chance to attend otherwise.

Figaro Children's Chorus

School Workshop- 18 July Centenary Heights State High School Performance: Tuesday 18 July 2017, Empire Theatre

As part of Opera Australia's return to Toowoomba in 2017, local young performers were offered the chance to audition to be part of the Regional Children's Chorus.

Selected members would be taught the chorus music of the production by an industry professional and perform in costume onstage with professional artists from Opera Australia. With the help of local chorus master Cherie Vera, the choir rehearsed over eight weeks prior to the Opera's arrival in town. While in town, the company also conducted a free schools workshop with Centenary Heights State High School music extension students.

More than 40 students auditioned to be a part of the chorus and 24 were successful in gaining the available places. Each student was able to learn about the music, techniques and the requirements of an operatic singer and get a real understanding of what it might be like to be a professional artist.

IMPACT

Thanks to the generous support of the Sidney Myer Fund and the Tim Fairfax Family Foundation's Capacity Building program, Empire Youth Arts has been able to continue the work of previous years by establishing the Senior and Junior IMPACT Ensembles in 2017.

The IMPACT Ensemble is an audition based collective that aims to offer young people professional performance experience, whilst making an impact on audiences. The Junior IMPACT Ensemble performed their original, *Child(ish)* on September 2-3, 2017, followed by the Senior Ensemble with *{Cross My Heart}* from October 13-14, 2017, both in The Armitage Centre: Heritage Bank Auditorium.

More than 20 young artists were engaged over the course of five month program, during which time they worked with a wide range of professional theatre and performance artists, leading to two 70 minute performances of their respective theatre pieces, to an audience of approximately 600 people.



Bursaries

The Empire Theatres Foundation supports young people in achieving their goals in the performing arts in the form of several valuable bursaries.

In the 2017/18 financial year, 25 young talented performers from various disciplines were presented with a collective amount totaling more than \$18,000, giving each the opportunity to attend short courses at Queensland Theatre, Jazz Music Institute, Expressions Dance Company, Sydney Dance Company, Brent Street Performing Arts, Victorian College of the Arts, Empire Theatre Youth Arts, Sound Thinking and ED5.

The biennial Brian Boak Outstanding Performer Bursary was also presented, allowing Melbourne based operatic lyric tenor Michael Petruccelli the opportunity to take up a prestigious scholarship with Opernstudio in association with Frankfurt Opera in Germany, one of the most important music theatres in Europe.



Farewell, Margaret Turnbull


